With the economic impact the current health crisis has had not only in our county, but the State of Michigan and the entire United States, we knew it was in our best interest to cancel this fair to be able to stay financially healthy.

The safety of our local youth and their families was at the forefront of our decision. Please note that there has already been discussion about how to conduct a virtual 4-H show and auction.
